**REPORT OF EXAM::**

CHEST CT WITH CONTRAST:

**CLINICAL HISTORY:**

56-year-old male, follow up pancreatic cancer.

**TECHNIQUE:**

Following injection of Isovue, 5 mm images were obtained through the chest. Abdominal findings will be reported separately.

**FINDINGS:** Compared with prior CT dated February 5, 2007.

**Index lesions are as follows:**

Left upper lobe nodule on image 135 is 7 x 3 mm, it was 5 x 3 mm.  
right upper lobe pleural-based somewhat linear density on image 142  
measures 6 x 5 mm, it was 6 x 3 mm.

Several other smaller nodules are noted along with increasing bilateral more confluent airspace consolidation as well as nodular septal thickening. The pleural effusions have slightly increased with minimal nodular pleural thickening.

**Impression:**

Worsening intrathoracic metastasis with lymphangitic spread.
